PARTNERSHIP WITH UNIVERSITY OF CAGLIARI, ITALY

Nile University has partnered with the University of Cagliari, Italy in many activities, due to the relations forged through the ERASMUS+ co-funded project IMPAQT, which included a Winter School that was designed and implemented at Nile University in February 2020.

The Summer School was designed by UNICA and implemented online in December 2021, as well as having UNICA team members invited as guest lecturers in several courses at the Architecture and Urban Design Program (ARUD) at NU. Currently post-IMPAQT project, and after these successful collaborations, the University of Cagliari, Italy, and Nile University have signed a Memorandum of Understanding that is covering a multitude of academic activities such as teaching, research and staff and student exchange, joint Diploma and master's degree, Ph.D. scholarship, joint courses, summer/ winter schools, study trips, etc.

This MOU will promote the interaction between NU and UNICA in mutually beneficial areas and ensure its sustainability.

SIGNING AN ERASMUS+ K1 MOBILITY AGREEMENT WITH THE SLOVAK UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY AT BRATISLAVA

The Architecture and Urban Design (ARUD) program at Nile University has signed an ERASMUS+ K1 Mobility Agreement with the Slovak University of Technology at Bratislava for the exchange of faculty and students to cover multiple activities up till July 2023. This opportunity enhances the internationalization of teaching and research at NU as well as at STU. It also allows NU students to benefit from a semester abroad and paves the way for funded research and a full MOU in the future.


